Whether it be a tractor, a sickle bar mower, a plow, or a lawn mower, whatever it is, the club will provide 25% of the costs **UP TO \$500** (this is of course so we are not financing the whole works, we are doing this to assist our younger members)

What are the requirements and how do we apply? If you answer yes to all the requirements, contact Jim at the contact info below and a form will be sent to you. The requirements are:

- Family must be current club member
- Applicant age 14-18
- Project must be older than 25 years old
- You must provide a description of the project, what direction you are taking it (paint only/mechanical/full restoration) with some details, and a photo of the project
- Provide an itemized list of the parts and costs of the project
- Show up to a meeting in January-May and July to give updates on the project
- Show project the next year (even incomplete)
- Provide information on other activities you are involved in (school/4H/etc) and parent/guardians information

When can we apply and when will we know if we won? Applications are accepted May-June-July, the decision on who wins will be made in August, and the announcement will be made in September

Who makes the decision on who wins award? We have a committee of 4 members who will review applications and make a decision
